A school organization helps the female staff to get Scooty in half price.



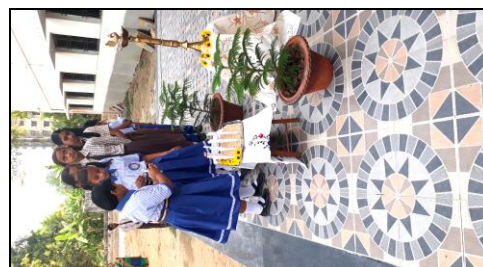
➤ **Conclusion: -**

The new academy year started with online classes since there was no other option. In the beginning the classes were given through Whatsapp but later on it was updated with Google meet live classes.

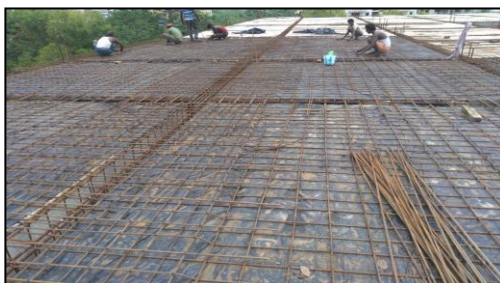
➤ **Staff meeting and training: -**
